



This following message is to notify City of Crockett Water Customers of a failure to submit a required report to TCEQ by the deadline, in 2022. All water samples and records show that water disinfection and monitoring requirements were met with no violation, but we failed to submit that report to TCEQ, as required. ***This violation was not related to your water quality.***

**Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The CITY OF CROCKETT water system PWS ID 1130001 has violated the reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of October, November, and December 2022.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

***All water disinfection and residual monitoring requirements were met with no violations during this time-period and recorded. These records are to be compiled and sent to TCEQ as a quarterly report. These reports were not submitted due to an extended leave of our Utility Superintendent. We are cross training other operators to cover reporting when the Superintendent is out or is unable to be available for report submission.***
