Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve a request for a Specific Use Permit from Cleotis Hickman for a mobile home to be located at 1005 Pear, Crockett, TX 75835. Legal description: being out of and a part of the A. E. Gossett Survey, a-423, 3/4th of a mile northeast from the courthouse in the City of Crockett, being the southeast 1/4 of lot 7 in Barbee Heights Addition to the City of Crockett. Council Member Beasley seconded the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

7. AWARD BID: GIGABIT CROCKETT INDUSTRIAL PARK PROJECT - EDA AWARD NO. 08-79-05379

Mayor Pro Tem Marsh seconded the motion. Motion passes 4-0.
